- Tue Aug 22<sup>nd</sup> clear and hot. I went over to see brother John who is no better
- Wed Aug 23<sup>rd</sup> clear and hot. I cut weeds out of corn and potatoes
- Thu Aug 24<sup>th</sup> cloudy and warm. I cut weeds out of the potatoes. game bragg called in a few minutes this afternoon
- Fri Aug 25<sup>th</sup> clear and pleasant. Victoria was here preparing to go back to Buffalo the boys and girls came in to night to bid her good bye they changed their mind concluded to have their photos taken to morrow
- Sat Aug 26<sup>th</sup> clear and pleasant. the photographer came we had our likeness taken Vic and her children started for home I went to see Brother John he is no better

- Sun Aug 27<sup>th</sup> clear and pleasant. I went with Bilton over to see Brother John who is no better. we went to hear the free Methodist preacher at the old Church
- Mon Aug 28<sup>th</sup> cloudy after noon and warm Bilton was here part of the fore noon.
- Tue Aug 29<sup>th</sup> fore part of the day clear and warm a heavy thunder storm about noon a pour down rain. I was helping Walter put a block under the sill of my granery after the rain
- Wed Aug 30<sup>th</sup> cloudy and wet fore part of the day latter part windy and hot 88 deg Elva Paul called to see our Photographs
- Thu Aug 31<sup>st</sup> cloudy and cool. I went over to see Brother John who is no better Walter was thrashing his grain and storing it away in my granery. John Smith called on me this evening. Some of our folks got their photos this evening that Dick brought in this afternoon
