Mostly cloudy got sunny late P.M. frosty thawing some in sunshine. Bob Lindale and I drove up to J. Blacks A.M. to see about getting a present for Andrew Johnson who enlisted last fall. We phoned over to Roy W. Hardy he wanted to canvass his

line. Bob Lindale was to canvass above Clark's sideline and along it I was to canvass below.

P.M. Willie and I drove up to station Lucy in cutter got our seed corn out of car from J Caldwell paid \$3.20 took corn along home then drove up to S W. Clark, Forks & Johnsons collecting for Andrews present then to Pick's Lass Fordschams saw Barlow as he brought the mail. Willie chopped P.M. cow horse. Another sheep had a lamb last night.
