17. Fine bright day. after a night of hard frost. The wind is cold and high I went for Birdie
18. Thanksgiving day very fine a good congregation offering for Cornwall G. Hospital To sugar 25. Lamb 15. Soap 10 50
19. Fine day. J. C. B. and Birdie went to Montreal last evening. And got home at 8.30 A. M today Pa was pretty busy. I took up some mangolds
20. Fine day. The girls took down the furnace pipes cleaned and varnished them. and put them up again. To 1 lb slat 2 lb coarse ransages 30^{cts}. D. H. M. D. paid 150 rent 30

22. Very fine day. To 1 gall coal oil 23. I made a small washing
- No word from Duncan since Friday. To 4 lbs stub 25^{cts}. Mrs D. L. McLennan was due to dinner began to drizzle about 7 P. M. my 7.30 P. M joining the Brown left for West. Murdy
