to be good yet though the scattered inhabitants of
the spring came and some of them is almost fast
to see so much ice and snow and more appeared
more. Lots of hay & straw Lashey came with his flour I
helping him to split the Maple Tree crossing yet
5th Lashey to a Sumner for the Remaining
part of the Order & gave him 12 lb of pork
5th Making his mits. Washing & mending Trench
Lashey went to Tom Cotters for his spear or to
see Phillips girls. Snowing & Blowing
crops good yet ice opened about this
time Last year 6th Sunday Lashey came
preparing to go to Hunt with Jim Hopkins to
the Place they call Soft Wood went off together
Mary Christie & the 2 girls came with the
Register & 2 Keens 1 Tom Cat to Leavenworth
till they come back Great Fighting of the Coon
Put on my new fine coat to wear Lent Lashey
6 of Ally's traps Snowing & Blowing some 7th
Christie to Keynon Mary & the other girl stop
here coming back from Summerstown I wrote
a letter for her to a gentleman in Fort Lawrence
J. Moore by name sold me one of the skins
for flour & great news concerning Francis
Catherine drawing wood from the upper
Point to the full I cant go to the Bank but
went with one load sent them a Bag went for
and they were away good must pretty good
weather 8th came home with the Bag John
Stone & Henry Birch at Christies along
Mary at night

Went to see Mrs Wom's very poorly
stopt all night 9th J. & Bill went to James
McElwain for hay that night went to the
Baptist Minister to be married James
Lucy Laura Elizabeth Emanuel Bill
Laura & myself Paid 3/- gave me a certificate
Mr Webb gave 3/9 J. & I stopt all night 10th
James came part of the way with us home
Lashey & James Hopkins came home from hunting
ice opened in some spots people crossing
a foot 11th seeing the canoe drawing wood teams
crossing at Lancaster Laura washing 12th swallows
came ice running drawing some wood 13th Palm Sunday
took in 8 Eggs 14th drawing some wood shooting began
Loons & Wild Geese Roaring 15th A Fox Left on the Island
Emanuel & Bill came fishing 8 lbs got 11 16th
3 Lambs to day a canoe going down North side with 2
in it at night Lashey came 17th went to see Sumner
Bought 1 3/4 worth of stuff Brought of Ant. B. & H.
1 lb best Tobacco Promised to go with the
Tom Peter Grants for Donald & the Phoebe
Lashey grinding his axe 18th our Duncan's Bark Day
Good Friday The River alive with Drift Wood
Saw logs cord Wood Boards Fence Nails Flatted & square
Sumner got 2 8 lbs in the mud drawing to the Point
Lashey commence the Big Maple tree cut 18 lbs shot
Duck for the first one I ever seen him shot
killing some Pens not flying very well. Map
Gray hearty 20th firing canoe water day shot a Rat
of the Lambs dead. He would not look at it throwing
shaves for
