Thursday

Sunny and cloudy stormy got calmer by night  
 got very frosty at night. Willie drove  
 down am got Belle's boot mended at Harold  
 30cts gave Betty Bros cheque on J.B. goods  
 for \$3.00 payment of promissory note on letter  
 carrier. I drove down at night went along  
 for Mary and we went to annual meeting  
 in our church. The question of selling the  
 manse was settled in the negative. When I  
 got home Mr Faunt came over to tell us Mrs  
 Mackie had died. I drove him down to tell  
 W. Thomas. Belle went over for awhile.  
 Willie cleaned and sorted turnips. Mary got  
 in Jan stamps & cards at Phillips 21cts at Russell's  
 pattern 20cts flannel 15 outmeal 10 got meat Shortbread  
 33cts Jan 12<sup>th</sup> got goods \$6.46 also got Jan 27 pie from  
 Red cross sale 88cts at Carnegie hall 20cts paid on Harold  
 X of \$50.00 also 8cts for button moulds
