Sunny and cloudy stormy got calmer by night got very frosty at night. Willie drove down AM got Bellas boat mended at Hamil 30cts gave Betty Bros change on SB job  
for \$43.00 payment of <sup>it</sup> promising note on letter carrier. I drove down at night went along for May and we went to annual meeting in our church. The question of selling the 462 manse was settled in the negative. When I got home Mr Faust came over to tell us Mrs Mackie had died. I drove him down to tell Mr Thomas. Belle went over for awhile.
