over to the other house for Tea Maryon working
on her dress

& they dressed on two loads or so & 3 for
them selves they raked to late & at Jennie
& Maryon could not go after bread
I picked & pulled cherries for two pies
& an apple sauce & jelly mixed. had
fire enough to roast an ox Jennie &
Maryon over to help Bathie with her dress. they
killed the old rooster. Clara down in the
all night the boys over for supper in the
house Roy stayed all night over there

the two boys helping them Clarence had 29
a falling out with them Paul came home
brought a letter from Fannie telling of
the birth of Donalds son day before
Sun 9 rather a nice day. Jennie over for
Tea in the other house & the boys Roy was there
for dinner we had cherry pie for supper
Wells had a swarm of bees & we had
a swarm on Thursday we put it in the key
I got everything ready & Paul Roy knocked
it down. I got stung under the eye
John & Ed to the other house. Bathie gone to Monday
Mon 10. Maryon & Jennie went to Cheffaco
in the forenoon got 8 loaves of bread. salt spread

we had a shower before breakfast. I churned
Paul stayed in home all day went at night
to Somerville. Arthur cut some on the new ground
the boys got Fears boat & went for a ride
