

Nov 1899

- 13 Dull day, I made a small washing
- 14 To pan bread 20^{cts} washed dining cupboard
- 15 Muddy away, washed kitchen cupboard
- 16 Ellen Bellmore cleaning sitting room 30^{cts} 50
 Grant Fitzgibbons buried yesterday died in Virginia, he was crushed between the cage and wall of a mine, Wednesday was an ugly day snowing and blowing
 To 3 lbs flour 33^{cts}
- 17 I laid the carpet on the sitting room floor Muddy away, kind of fine day
- 18 Fine and bright, Muddy away, To bed 20
 To buy 40, rooled wheat 25
 Starched and put up curtains
- 19 Fine bright day, preaching in afternoon
 Rev McFinger from Lancaster text - John 8-32
- 20 Fine day, Amstall 1/2 day 25, Muddy a little better
- 21 Bright day, Muddy has a bad cold
- 22 I washed & blanked all old, I ripped 5 of them to turn, Killed two roosters
 To 3 lbs steak 30^{cts} To pan bread 25 50
- 23 I was up early, Jimmie (4 peck) Col. Perryman and Mayor Colush to inspect, the cows with a team, and I thought they would remain to dinner, but they had ordered dinner at Sawros
 To 42 lb tea 20^{cts} ^{for his wife} ^{lugar on} ^{luncheon}
- 24 Jimmie is helping Bellmore who has the thrashers
 We got 74 bush of oats To pan bread 20^{cts} Muddy at work, the crops alive, Kate Campbell has gone to hospital
- 25 Muddy came in at 11 P. M. Very high winds, Jimmie is helping Bellmore, H. D. M. came with 15 bush oats they finished thrashing, To 2 lbs butter 50^{cts} took at fair
- 26 Sunday, Mr. Hubert, Bible Society Agent, Reached
 Gave a good address, text in Genesis
 Rain all afternoon.

November 1900

- 27 Monday Muddy left for Nat. High days
- 28 Snow at noon, Mostly day, nothing doing
- 29 Rain and all the snow off. To 1 gall coal oil 20
 4 loaves 20
- 30 Bright, but cold west wind, Mrs J. B. B called
 Pat at the fair 1 lb knitting yarn 50^{cts} 2 white & black 50
 1 pair white w x 30, lamp chimney 5, Muddy got home about 7 P. M. 35
