Being to the amount of work (I partly careless-
ness) I have neglected my diary during the fall season, but
shall notice some of the principal events.

It has been one of the finest seasons throughout
that I ever knew. We got along quite well with our
work, & made nearly 800 gallons of S. Syrup of our
own raising, we finished shaking on the 14th October.
Broke our stone mill once. Thomas came home
about the 20th October and helped husk corn &c.

I plowed about 3 acres for spring wheat in
December.
