Cool, breezy, rain at times also hail intermixed with sunshine. Willie finished cultivating corn. He went down P.M. for tile car had not come so got at Nichols 300. 3 m to 60 4 m on fr. Ditches got 3 more drains made in No 6 running S.E. and laid with 3 in and 2 1/2 in at ends and one running N.W. from main next bush fence laid with 4 in tiles. Willie got pick sharpened at Hodge 1007.

Wednesday

Cold last night and very cold day also windy mostly cloudy. N.D. up all day he helped us deepen open ditch with scraper A.M. started to thin mangels after dinner then drove waggon to station & back with tiles from car that came to-day. We got 3 loads ^{made 3/2} 500 in 1st load 350 & 75 6 m second load 400 3/2 in 120, 4 m and 22 6 m 3rd load I dug some more open till P.M. they got 2 more drains dug in No 6 running N.E. to the 4 in main put in last night then brought ditches down to open ditch. 7 & 11 up to-day walked both ways. Wore
