Differential Diagnosis of Convulsions.

A trustworthy means of differentiating between hysteria and epilepsy, and one that cannot be imitated is the behavior of the white corpuscles. While the latter show no change whatever after an hysterical attack, they increase greatly in number after a genuine epileptic seizure. Leucocytoses of 20,000 or over are not uncommon. They drop rapidly after the convulsions cease and soon attain normal values again.—*Joedicke; Münch. Med. Woch.*
