- 13. Pretty showery all day now 9.40 P.M. raining heavily. Finished putting up the lace curtains, am pretty well through with house cleaning To steak 30. 1 gal coal oil 53

The papers are full of news about the atrocious massacre of the Royal family of Belgrade in Austria. Tuesday night 12 of June. King Alexander his queen his two brothers, the premier, the Minister of war and two aides de camps were killed, To pan bread 20

- 24. The entrance exams began today. Bella Cameron's name Wellington is here to try the exams fine day, after the rain yesterday Murdy at Dalkeith Got our account from D. Mowbray Agent £2.50
- 25. Rain all last night and rain all today To 1 pan bread 20. Sugar 25 45
- 26. Dull day, no rain, all low land is flooded Had a letter from Jimmie, but in Kingston Exams closed at 3 P.M. Cleaned in garden
- 27. A.M. Fine. Sold 3 doz eggs 39. To 1 lb soap 28. Cheese 28
33. To 3 lbs lard 45. To pepper 7. Cash and 1/2 of old due bill 85
Steak 33. Pan bread 20
- 28. Rain To pan bread 20 Fine day. Rev K. Mc Don in afternoon in St Andrews. Birdie & Mary were here for short time
- 29. I washed some things. 5 sheets & pillow slips
- 30. Rained all day, some heavy showers Sent a letter to Marvon one to Bella Cameron, forwarded one from Lisheard to Jimmie
