- March 20 Snowed about 12 inches last night went to Mill
14 Bushel of wheat then I went to Mullington
with 42 butter pinks to F Lee for 9 Clingham
but Lee was broke down & we had to bring ^{back} them
- 21 Snowed all day made 3 buckets
- 22 went to caintown & heard the Revd Mr Penning preach
- 23 went Llyn with 42 pinks roads very bad hard frost last ^{night}
- Taped 140 trees this afternoon the sap runs a stream
- 24 worked in the Bush the buckets mostly full
- 25 fixed some buckets taped a few more
- 26 worked in the Bush sap runs well
- 27 went to Dixson with A Maple log 9 feet
long for trumps for the Cheshing Machine
then drew in part of A Stack of hay
- 28 went Wickes with A Slaughter Croke
then finished drawing in the hay the snow
nearly gone of the roads Llyn & water
boiled 70 pailfulls of sap it has been a
great week for Sugar
- 29 went to caintown & heard the Revd Mr
Mc Murray preach
- 30 worked in the Sugar bush warm day
- 31 went to Mr Nblackes got £ 3 from him
for hub stuff

Sold Dixson 5 pounds worth of ske logs
& Nblack 5 pounds of hub stuff

Took young or for stuff for his stave
oil 1.6 red lead 3 iron 16.3
