opened the yard fence put the  
Hay in the Barn Cool and  
Windy to night Gonia Passed up 14<sup>th</sup>  
Wind Blowing hard Raining hard cool  
Shot 4 Ducks Sittles Island South  
Lucias here Sunday got Butter

James Cameron Island 15<sup>th</sup> October 1898  
& Wind Cool Raining a Few Grains of  
Snow shot 3 Ducks a Bird Passed up  
with 2 in it Received a Letter from  
John Cameron Kansas Fernandez  
went for the Mail Bought of Mr  
Hagarty Oil Thud 2 Bars of Soap  
16<sup>th</sup> Sunday Gordon came and went off  
took my Coat John H came had a  
New Watch got some Ducks Seander  
11 Boxed them up Directed them to  
San The Temple St James Street Montreal  
& Wind 17<sup>th</sup> & Wind Seander crossed to  
Summervtown to give Haggarty the Box  
To take to the Station Fernandez  
Went down to Cat Island to hunt  
got 1 Duck Tried the new Plough  
for the first time in the oak field  
Gough's good Gordon came took my  
Coat and Tools to work at Hamilton  
18<sup>th</sup> St. Sittles Day & Wind High a good  
Lot of Shooting Ploughing Digging  
Behind the Barn cutting up Dead  
nut Trees at the fence Killed
