Diagnosis of Chronic Nephritis and Neurasthenia.

Chronic Nephritis with threatening uremia may sometimes present a group of symptoms in a neuropathic individual which might be mistaken for neurasthenia, e. g., headache, characterized by tightness and feeling of pressure, especially in the morning, giddiness, weariness and lassitude with inaptitude for mental or bodily work, diurnal somnolence, etc. An examination of the heart, the urine, the pulse and the retina will enable a diagnosis to be made.—Dr. F. W. Mott; *The Practitioner*.
