fixed the Syrup and

Measured it 51 Gallons  
Weighed the Sugar 115 lb

24<sup>th</sup> Fine High South W Wind  
Fernandez went to Lancaster  
took a cake of sugar to  
a Frasers first ploughing  
on the Lower Point corn ground  
and at the cherry tree  
piled some stove wood

Unfortunate Day 25<sup>th</sup> St  
MARKS DAY Rain Fine W Wind  
Ploughing at Lower Point Piling  
stove wood Fernandez came  
had corn and several sorts  
of potatoes The Chaffy into  
Lancaster

26<sup>th</sup> Alexander and Fernandez went  
to Dundee with boxes, Rats Bought  
a pair of boots for me Soap

James Cameron Island 27<sup>th</sup> April 1895

Fine E Wind Ploughing Potato Ground  
Putting Manure on Potato Ground  
Making Picquets 75 made now  
Setting fires on the Pitt Point  
Setting a Hen with Duck Eggs  
Fernandez got 9 Eggs in the mud  
28<sup>th</sup> Fine High Gordon crossed  
and Capt A. J. Baker  
crossed to Fort Corrington  
to see James Y. Cameron

Coming home I came this  
way 29<sup>th</sup> Fine Ploughing and  
Putting manure on the Potato  
Ground taking away the Banking  
from the house Drawing Paths  
to the Piece Below the Grove  
for a garden Making cedar  
Picquets went up in the Boat  
the Boat a Propeller went  
down for the first lights set

up to night taking the Potatoes  
out of the Kellar shot a Fish Hawk  
30<sup>th</sup> Cool E Wind Mr Gene came to  
Gene fixing the Boats yesterday  
David Brown sent me a lot of Eggs  
I sent him all I had of Duck Eggs  
- 6 Alexandra went down  
propeller dug with 4 Barges  
Cutting seeds of Potatoes
