 John harrowed Potatoes & I & Angus went to
 A B's for a pig Angus staid at H Store's till
 I came from A B's I & boys brought load
 edgings & fished awhile this evening
 no slight shower a.m., fine rain this evening
 Aaron went home last night
 Sunday 2 Went to J D's P.m. W. Cloudy. Shower
 a.m. fine heavy rain P.m. growing weather
 3 I took Castings of Old Canada Reaper to
 Unionville bought a sulky Horse Rake @ 35.00
 was allowed \$15.00 for Castings Aaron fished road at
 dam & turned hay in Orchard. W. fine Clear
 4 Drew dung on fallow ^{took more dung to French House} no shower at noon
 I took more again this morning to J Peter's
 5 Had J Mainland to fill dung a.m. got
 fallow covered & few loads on heap near dam
 till noon very heavy rain at noon Cleared lobst
 6 Went to J Milner's they were not at home
 then went to J Lehman's. they gave us a ride
 through Stouffville then we went to J H
 Ramer's I got horses shod. W. pretty warm
 7 Finished Churny wheat & Aaron split
 wood & fished some fence & I took first
 Chop to Cedar Grove Mills. after supper
 W. shower a.m. heavy rain after dark
 8 Both spread some dung & began to cross plow
 till too warm then hoed Corn & turned hay in Orchard
 till noon Aaron went to Bee at Schoolhouse
 to level Play ground I & little boys brought
 some Chop & raked & Coaked hay I brought
 home Buggy after dark W. the hottest day
 so far J H Ramer was here at supper for some
 Sunday 9 I & Children & Amos went to Meeting ^{Potatoes} at

 No after service. W. very very hot shower this
 10 Both Plowed & opened out hay Coaks ^{evening}

 11 Both Plowed. W. Cooler. rain last night
 12 Finished Plowing this morning. then I & John scuffed
 till Corn & fed Corn a.m. drew in hay out of old Orchard
 2 loads till supper made rack for spring Wagon
 after supper. W. very warm & Close P.m.
 13 I & Angus & Herman went to Toronto. sold
 Butter @ 25¢ 1 Calf & 2 lambs for \$9.00 Bay
 old Potatoes \$1.00. W. fine pretty warm
 14 I went to Mongolin a.m. Mowed newly
 half of Meadow P.m. W. fine. breeze from north
 15 I & little boys killed a calf a.m. I took quarters
 to A Moyses & a piece to Uncle C B's family then
 we Raked & Coaked all the hay that I had cut
 little John worked the new rake very well
 Took 10 bag Peas to mill after supper
 Sunday 16 Susanna & I Lewis & Benjamin staid
 with Mother the rest of us went to Meeting
 at Debon remarks by B. C. Sermon on
 by Rev Jos Basky J H Ramer's were here
 after service I & Angus went to C B's P.m.
 Alene McVair was here this evening we had not
 seen him for over 13 years he lives in Illinois
 17 Finished Mowing Meadows till supper scuffed
 Potatoes after supper. W. pretty warm
 18 Raked & Coaked all the hay a.m. I & John
 Piled some lumber & brought home Chop. P.m.
 19 Drew in 11 loads hay W. very warm
 20 Shovel Plowed feed Corn & Potatoes & scuffed
 some ~~of~~ turnips. Aaron hoed turnips. W. shower
 last night & heavy thunders. slight shower today
 21 Drew in last hay till supper 7 loads Both helped B. C.
 bind wheat after supper. W. fine pretty Cool
 22 Aaron went to W M's barn raising on Henry Peter's
 place (W. M. bought it) I & little boys hoed turnips
 I went to Markham P.m. W. Cloudy a.m. rain & me
 23 Went to Meeting at Widener's Remarks by Rev Jos Basky
