she died very sudden last night W. fine
3 I hauled A.M. I & Henry ached
& Esther went to funeral of Lohman
wife young Saml Harvey & Well
oughty officiated. B^r helped very
little W. rain last night & A.M.
a little drizzly P.M. at times
4 I helped J. D. finish thresher while this
morning then he & J. brought load wood
from other bush. H got Frank & Doll
shod & A began plowing in barley
stubble east of wheat east of dam
A.M. I & Nancy started after dinner
with B^r C & Beey to go to Vantage
Boys plowed P.M. I helped Polkey
move old Church, we went to
Daniel Smiths to supper then
to Saml Smiths to stay all night
W. fine & clear
Sunday 5 went to Meeting at Vantage
remarks & sermon on St Mat 21st
by B^r C went to Abraham Smiths

^{Oct 1890}
To dinner then came home W. fine
a little cloudy P.M. few drops rain
6 Boys chow chow on east side of bag
stubble east of wheat J. Plowed A.M.
I went to Burrows for powder for
Gow Rhody chow P.M. killed Pig
just before dinner W. east wind
A.M. rain all P.M. boys & girls
went to J. D. after supper
7 Boys & B^r C. cut Bee tree great big
Gum in B^r C's bush A.M. got fine
hot honey & swarm Bees don't know
if Bees will stay or not they plowed
P.M. W. drizzly more or less all day
I have swelled face & Toothache
8 J. & Susanna & Henry went to Markham
A.M. other boys plowed, began in field that
was gazed N.E. corner field. W. fine
9 H made about 65 gals cider A.M. we boiled
a Kettle full P.M. Boy plowed W. fine
my face is very sore. Teeth ulcerated
10 Boys cleaned grist mill then they
went to Markham about 2 past 10 o'clock
I & Nancy boiled Kettle full same W. rain
till near noon clear P.M.
