and berry bushes part of the day
- Sat Mar 23rd cloudy. a few drops of rain fell this
morning. Sarah brought me a couple of ~~loaves~~

- Sun Mar 24th cloudy and cool.
- Mon Mar 25th clear and pleasant. I starting the
coal stove in the fore noon. after noon
I was setting a few straw berry plants
