- Fri Mar 15<sup>th</sup> cloudy and cool. Bilton was

-ring house and baking pies
- Sat Mar 16<sup>th</sup> clear and pleasant the frost  
going out of the ground fast
- Sun Mar 17<sup>th</sup> cloudy and cool the latter part  
of the day. I went to the church and  
heard the young man preach
- Mon Mar 18<sup>th</sup> cloudy and cold in the morning  
a hard frost last night. Sarah came for  
the dirty cloaths. I saw two Robbins  
over in Newcombs yard this after noon

- Fri Mar 22<sup>nd</sup> cloudy and warm. Sarah was here  
cleaning house. I was trimming grape vines  
and berry bushes part of the day
- Sat Mar 23<sup>rd</sup> cloudy. a few drops of rain fell this  
morning. Sarah brought me a couple of ~~loaves~~  
loaves of bread this evening.
- Sun Mar 24<sup>th</sup> cloudy and cool.
- Mon Mar 25<sup>th</sup> clear and pleasant. I starting the  
coal stove in the fore noon. after noon  
I was setting a few straw berry plants  
Sarah was in a couple of times.
