 from Lewis got a Tomble from Summers store 10th
 fishing got 53 Perch fishing and cleaning the Potatoes
 11th Sunday went away with John Angus for the
 12th stop on Francis Island the first time ever Lord
 was on it Heard George McCall was found to be
 mate on the sea yesterday fishing got 12 Perch and
 2 Rovers had 1 1/2 of Mince cleaning the corn and
 Potatoes wind high blowing in the evening 13th Mince
 cleaning the corn of 1000 the other of 1000 for to go to Renshaws
 14th the wind to Renshaws Tom & Pat for fish Christ
 15th crossed Potatoes 5 of them good 1/3 dropped
 south side of the river had only 1/3 left 16th
 at Sunday to the Renshaws getting 1/3 of the
