- 29th Went to Mrs Frank Kitchens sale in the afternoon.
- 30th ^{Was a load of spoiled hay to Paris by Post, Mr Donald.}
- 31st Feb. Drew turnips to Jas Wallace at the Glen.
- Feb. 3rd Red cow had a nice roan calf.
- 4th A very cold day, the thermometer going at night to 20 to 25° below zero.
- 6th Started to draw manure to Creek Field.
- 7th Went to Brantford in the afternoon, took tea at Mrs R. Wright's.
