March 17 Went to Landedown to look at land that the Messrs Colmans wanted Father & Gock to take for the damage that is done to them Land is was lot No 10 & the west half of 11 on the sixth concession the snow was so deep we could not travel on it but we looked at the front of it it is <sup>one</sup> compleat set of malls or rocks with very little good land we gave it up for a bad job Samuel Yonge went with us

18 drew wood Benz Yonge & his wife <sup>at 10</sup> with us & slept all night ~~at 10~~ so as to go to Johns

19 Father & Gock went to Lynn to let the Colman know that the Land is no good & that they will not take it & digged up some of the Cabage they were good

20 drew wood 21 drew wood fine day

22 Gock went to McElhenrys Mill with 13 bushel of clatch wheat & 4 bushel of peas & went to Brockville gave Turner a barrel of spud <sup>then</sup> Apples & I had some cabage sold them for 8 <sup>2 ears</sup> attended Sidney Jones Esqrs funeral

23 went to Brockville & heard the Revd W. Spence <sup>of Brytoun</sup> Baplyzed Elizabeth fine way <sup>of</sup> Watson daughter <sup>of</sup> <sup>W. Watson</sup>

24 drew wood Snow in the afternoon

25 drew wood fine day

26 went to yorange Mills with 14 flour <sup>grain</sup> barrels for Elingham & brought some <sup>the</sup>

27 drew a load of wood then fixed the appels

28 Gock went to Brockville with 3 barrels <sup>of</sup> Appels got 3 dollars per barrel <sup>of</sup> & 4 <sup>of</sup> for cabage & went to John yonges to make a ladder for him <sup>with</sup> snow

29 came home from John yonge cold no meeting to day fine day

30

31 went to Brockville took 1 barrel of appels sold them for 3 dollars Pomogus slaighing nearby gone hard frost last night
