 tea at Aunt Isablas got to Gouanague at night
 28 got home to day Ellen Lizzie & Bessie ^{with us}
 with me Gouanague is no better ^{than the Rev. J. B. B.}
 29 had potatoes the Rev. D Brill went to Kingston
 this morning the ground is very dry
 30 went to Gouanague with 15 bushel of wheat
 that I bought from N Kindrick it weighed
 only 14 bushel & 15 lbs at the mill I bought
 half a bushel of western corn from W Norton
 to plant the corn that we planted in the spring
 did not ^{all} come up I sowed it for feed
