Gynecological Hints.

If a patient is thirsty after a laparotomy small quantities of water, hot or cold, should be given at short intervals. I usually instruct the nurse to let the patient have all the water she wants in teaspoonful amounts. If a large quantity of water is given at a time, it is apt to cause vomiting. On the other hand, a small quantity at frequent intervals will frequently arrest nausea and vomiting.—Waldo; Int. Journ. of Surg.
