 near A.S.R. The body of Mr Cushing was taken
 out of the river at washing greens to-day his drowning
 is a mystery yet. I chopped pig and cow A.M.
 cut & split wood cleaned up yard and hosed
 in garden and orchard P.M. I put carbon
 bisulphite in 16 ground hog holes in evening
 on sand hill we still poltice Patay Mand's
 colt on milk. Wm Magwood brought meat
 Willie got strainer paid mended at Mr. Clamham 10 cts

80 Fine sunny day cloudy at times not very
 warm. Willie finished road work this A.M.
 hauling 3 loads to J.L. he supplied corn with
 corn cultivator also plowed some rope land P.M.
 I put cross slates and riders on lane fence bottom
 of rope in No 3. A cleaned out stables etc. P.M.
 I hoed 6 rows of the experimental mangels
 staked out 2 rows for a plot put No 2 N of S on the
 2 rows next row of trees N.W. No 3 N of S
 on next 2 rows and No 4 N of S on next rows
 I chopped some horse and cow in evening
 Willie got at F & S groceries 55 cts of flour 25 cts.
