1527 Rhoda and Mand. Harry Armstrong in at noon to tell us our corn was down at car Willie drove down got it from J Caldwell paid \$4.70 for it got 2 bundles lath at from A. Richardson 60c got force pump at Beathes 1402 paid by cheque on R.B. Mary sold Pullens to ray man 2 cts. Mary sent B.S. money to 7 Pritchard gave 2.00
