 Drifting 20<sup>th</sup> very cold and Frosty and Frosty  
 and cold to night the cut of Holly on the East  
 snow Done Finished the pile of Shove wood Between  
 the Elms and oak Frosty night 21<sup>st</sup> St Agnes 2<sup>nd</sup> day  
 a very Cold Day Windy and Frosty (air holes) Shuted  
 up and smoking put in the east of the 3 Ton stack  
 about 1/2 Ton a cold Frosty night this week was  
 very cold and Frosty Potatoes got a touch of Frost  
 to night 22<sup>nd</sup> Frosty cold Windy 23<sup>rd</sup> E Wind turned  
 a little warmer Frosty to night Drove a couple of  
 handsleigh Loads of Wood from the Bay cut Water  
 for the cattle Frocing around the cattle air-hole shut  
 up a good piece Teams on the Lancaster Road  
 24<sup>th</sup> Charlie Supper's Birth Day and its cold  
 Frosty Windy I went up to the 13<sup>th</sup> ay 7 weed  
 Leanders Trap Lwinia not well with a very  
 Bad Headache seen a Man crossing from  
 the south side a very Large crack or a  
 Burst in the ice crossing to the south or to  
 Christie's Island from below the Stages  
 Island not very well myself Frosty to  
 night good Fires 25<sup>th</sup> Robt Blwinis B<sup>d</sup> day  
 a very cold Blustry Dazond cold night  
 Conversion of St Paul 26<sup>th</sup> cold and Frosty  
 27<sup>th</sup> cold Frosty Blowing a horse and sleigh to Christie's

 West wind cold Frosty windy Eclipse on the Moon  
 got a House-Kit in the Trap a good many of  
 the air holes shut with this long spell of Frost  
 the air-hole Before the house not all shut yet  
 28<sup>th</sup> Lewis The Indians 3 children here for Milk gave  
 them some Sex for the children John H went off to  
 Mr Mr Dougalls 30<sup>th</sup> Leander went after John H  
 went to see how Rosell was as she is very poorly  
 Fine 31<sup>st</sup> Fine I went to Summertown sent for  
 the Witness and picture 1/25 postage and Register 5  
 sent 1 Dollar to Mr Rowter paper Envelope Register  
 sent Bought 2 pencils 2 Mr Mr Rherson would  
 take no pay for fixing the Dasher seen Mr Hill  
 heard Nicholsons was seized for smuggling took  
 some Leanders Munk fixing a track on the ice  
 for a course to run Lewis 2 children here for Milk  
 seen The Rev Mr Grant took home the other  
 Sack of Flour from Hamiltons to Lemmy Drawing  
 Wood from Lewis at Christie's Island 1<sup>st</sup> of February  
 Fine Leander went to Fort Covington to Boots 2.50  
 got a Ride to Summertown 2<sup>nd</sup> Candlemas Day  
 Leander not Well Fine The Bear and the Kacoon  
 will see their Shadows to Day as the Sun shines  
 Stanley and I Broke on the Stack at Lemmys  
 Stable 3 Ton in it West Wind 3<sup>rd</sup> put in some hay  
 4<sup>th</sup> E Wind Drifting snowing Races in Summertown  
 Court in Cornwall 5<sup>th</sup> Sunday snowing Blowing  
 to the West went to the Bush cut some Wood Fine  
 snow Deep in the Bush 7<sup>th</sup> E Wind Fine went  
 to the Bush caught a nice little Bird took off  
 my Coat and Threw it on her putting snow  
 of the East shed
