

July 16 Henry drew in 2 loads of hay from the north field & from the orchard put them in west half of the big mow then Cornett helped him I am not able to do any thing

rain 17 finished cutting the north field very heavy rain this afternoon the best rain we have had since April

18 shingled part of the south side of the barn I had to come down from it with my head raked part of the north field this afternoon rain to night

rain 19 rain last night & this morning Henry & Ellen went to Gonaogue took 9 bushel of wheat with them to the mill there is no grinding they brought it back with them they took Mr Mathews & Mr Gordon from <sup>there</sup> at night

20 the Rev. Mr Robinson preached in the morning & Mr Gordon

21 I went to Gonaogue for the lid of the mill. Con they forgot it on Saturday. Henry began the mow in the field below the house this morning he & the girls drew in 1 load of hay from orchard & 2 from the north field put them in the east half of the big mow fine day

22 raked & drew in one load at night mowed

23 put the load that we drew in yesterday in the little mow fine day finished cutting this side of the ditch

24 cut in the east side of the ditch or trees drew in one load put over the horses got 1 shee on

+ since it was put on with a new kind of nails  
25 went to Excote with 9 Bushel of wheat got home by noon drew in one load of hay put it over the cow stable & one load in the New barn for the sheep rain at dusk

rain 26 Henry cutting east of the Bull pasture little rain this morning

27 the Rev. Mr Mathews preached this morning & Rev. Mr Selony at night

28 Henry & Mr Cornett raked & drew in all that was in the field below the house which brought his barn & raked with it then they in Bell & drew in & cut the <sup>South</sup> half of the middle field rain to night

rain 29 cut part of the North half of the middle field which & Henry <sup>shingled</sup> & drew in 3 loads of the North field this afternoon two when <sup>shingled</sup>

30 Henry cut part of the North field I was not able to do any thing

31 Henry finished cutting the north field that is the best of rain cut & drew in 3 loads Mr <sup>Mathews</sup> & Cornett helped & could do nothing
