Cold day mostly cloudy milder to-day. We put on load turnips in A.M. 3 horses in wagon Willie took it down to Scharis in P.M. 87 bushels. I pulled turnips in P.M. Doug. McLean pulling also in P.M. Mrs Knox up for dinner. Mother up in P.M. Sold lamb skin to Scharis 25cts. Received from Mrs Knox for butter \$1.00

Cool cloudy some sunshine. Willie plowed in No 6 4 horses in A.M. and in P.M. took load turnips down to Scharis 91 bushels we got in another load and upset it in ditch on road over. I worked at turnips to-day.

Very hard frost last night ground frozen hard fine sunny day. We got wagon out of ditch fixed it up put about 70 bushels of the turnips on it Willie took them down and in P.M. took another load down 2 horses 93 bushels I pulled and trimmed. Willie downtown at night got at J Woods dress goods 25cts
