31 went to funeral of Simon

sharp & strong east wind A.M.  
began to snow fast about noon  
snowed all P.M. throwing at bed time  
boys cleaned some seed barley P.M.  
April 1 H & B helped J cut wood  
we boiled Sap I & J brought load old  
Pine from other bush to Sugar Camp & J  
brought home Chop. he drew some logs  
for Jesse Rason P.M. W. Snow throwing  
a little slightly, rained awhile P.M.

wood P.M. W. drizzly rain A.M.  
Cloudy P.M. a little drizzly towards  
evening Mary & Henry went to Cedar

back Marc Borroy. that Simon Stover  
had bought from us last December  
his widow has no use for her  
The snow is nearly all gone roads very bad  
3 H & B helped J cut wood A.M. J & B  
went to G Duncans sawing Bee P.M.  
J Mary & Henry went to Markham  
& let Job of Stumping about 10 acres  
to G Kelly's man P.M. I & A boiled  
Dep P.M. W. a little drizzly A.M.  
getting colder. A wind P.M.  
4 Boys cut wood J & A brought  
load old pine to Camp from other  
place & load sawdust for bedding  
we cleaned 30 bus seed barley for  
P Lewis his man took it away  
W. very cold A wind freezing hard  
Sandy & all went to Meeting at Hebron  
except J remarks & sermon on St Mat
