 fattened chickens down to A. Armstrong @ 13 cts
 \$7.15. 55 lbs brought up 7 & M. he got at Phillips
 8 60 order for \$8.54 for gasoline B.A. Oil Co sends order 6 cts
 I finished plowing new orchard and plowed some
 of rape land No 3. A. P.M. Jack Black plowed
 up to Achais that he would take Blackie car for
 \$62.00 so we took her to station and got the money
 went in to see Wm. Maywoods cow on way
 back. I drove 7 & M down in evening then
 went to Alex Moins and audited leafy accounts.

 subsided. I finished plowing rape land No 3. A.
 and brought load wood from around orchard fence
 on sledge to house. Willie took 7 chickens to
 Ewing that we plucked yesterday afternoon. got
 1 40 15 cts per lb 4 3/4 lbs \$6.53 got 100 lbs sugar 1 25
 oatmeal \$5. P.M. I plowed 2 1/2 round No 6 with horse plow who
 handles books, then I brought hammers from turnip land to other barn then took up
 roller. Willie chopped corn. Miss Hammers and up for tea and evening
