- 16 Rained this forenoon. boys went to work in afternoon. There were three men with two bears went through the village. The bears were light brown. Curly grown whose with big tufts of hair on their backs between neck & shoulders. Bungough of "Grass" will be in Lancaster tonight sowed citrus
- 17 Fine day planted cucumber melons water & musk. got 100 lb flour from Dunlop \$3.25. Jimmie sowed bush oats, 2 1/2 bush wheat
- 18 Murdy harrowed the grain Jimmie went to Lancaster after dinner and remained until the 7.30 train. and cousin Jimmie of Toronto came home with him got 1/2 gall coal oil 1 box crackers 30c
- 19 Fur came home last night and went off tonight - Saturday was very hot mercury was up here to 90-88 in Monroia. D. preached in Givens place today
- 20 It began to rain last night Jimmie Brown left at 9 P.M. for Lancaster in boat for Toronto. Posher paid \$5 - rent
- 21 Jimmie was getting new seed 2 bush 2.50 - for seed, bought of Ferguson, little 3rd
- 22 Ploughed the field by graveyard and planted some potatoes I was not at Prayer
- 23 fixed some fences on the Cook farm
- 24 Friday. Ben worked in forenoon ploughed in afternoon Murdy worked all day repairing Ben's coop
- 25 finished planting the church lot I planted seed of Mang - but carrots
