- Thur Jan 19. Raw east wind followed by heavy rain in afternoon. a terrific wind and rain in the evening. water high in ditches.
- Fri Jan 20. A very high wind and quite cold. Soft Ball girls Euchre. I did not go. I got oysters 45cts a jar. at Annie's
- Sat Jan 21. Fair and very cold zero the first this season. Annie here at night. roads all clear and dry on pavement. I phoned M.
- Sun Jan 22. Fine bright and quite cold. I was at morning and eve church, out for a walk in afternoon.
- Mon Jan 23. Fine and moderately cold. I walked out to see Mary orie who is poorly. Miss Eddy called. she and I at Vestry meeting the same wardens elected. a perfect eve.
- Tue Jan 24. Rained most of the day. then during the night turned much colder. and quite a fall of snow
