 P.M. harrowed in No 1 & I disked garden.
 We have got some seeds in it. Mary down in

 goods Steels 43 dress goods Russell's on 1.15
 eggs to set from mother 10 butter money 46.
 I went down to lecture in School Room on Heroes
 of Canada by Mrs M. Vior Mary there came up
 with her admittance 30 cts.
