Another warm sunny day. Willie drove down for 7 & M in morning I took them down about 5 P.M. We finished cutting No 2 hay and cut some in No 6 at other barn. We got in 4 loads this P.M. including rakkings we have No 1 finished complete No 2 ready for rakkings almost. Mauds colt still alive but very weak. saw had 3 pigs to-day. Grogan brought meat morning.

Cloudy rained A.M. also a little P.M. Willie drove down in morning got at Chapmans guards & sections for motor oil. 13. he brought N.S. up with 12 & him. we raked some at No 4 took back waggon and loader in time to be stopped by rain when and I took the 13 cattle up to Aclaus fifty again and fixed the fence, they got out and were down here this morning. Willie killed pig and in P.M. made horse. I scuffled mangel in N.O. P.M. took Kate up to Rogers at night. also took salt to cattle. Maudie over in evening. Bob Inidale down A.M. to get wire for his pea harvester. N.S. went home down
