my cloth from the weaver
and one calf skin 3.35
- 8 Raining. Grandma Clark came to Annie yes
today and left for home today. They
will be apt to have no snow the road
is very soft. I went to Annie to see gran
ma.
- 9 I was in church, M Gillivray is commencing
the Temperance Crusade
- 10 Temperance Meeting tonight Rev M Gill
Methodist from Cornwall lectured
Lewis sent in his resignation a secretary
Miss Genl Ross sang Mrs Loftis Josephine
Grant accompanied her on the organ
- 11 I baked today and hung out the clothes
- 12 I was taken with tooth ache last evening
and I did not go to bed but sat in
a chair. Maryory Fraser was here all
night
- 13 Still head ache & tooth ache

- 14 Rain, now it is what carriages, no sleighing 50
- 15 7. 1 lb tea at D McKees 50 cts 50
- 16 I was in Church in the morning & evening
- 17 made a little washing
- 18 O. Donnell the man who shot Curry the
informant on board of a vessel, was hung
in London ^{England} yesterday
- got 11 lbs granulated sugar at Willis's 1.00
he is selling by auction Keven's is his
auctioneer They are not selling much
- 20 Who should come to the house about
- 21 1 O'clock but McKillip the Bard, he
was on his way from Martintown where
he had been attending the Celtic
meeting in McGill College, he will
go away tomorrow with the mail for
Martintown. John W. Calder bought
a sewing machine to our place and
wants us to buy it it is 45 dollars
- 22 Saturday very cold and stormy, looks
like snow McKillip is off
- 23 Sabbath very cold it was 20 below zero
I did not go to church
- 24 Snowing, there is to be a banquet
in Russells Hall for Lewis, got 2 lb apples 25
Sarah Smith is knitting a hood for
Marron. I am not making much
preparation for Christmas, sent a letter
to Family, got money 5-
