- 9 Large Congregation. R. Murnd assisted Mr. Givin offering for Home Missions. Pa's off. 2.00 2.00
- 10. I have a cold we made the washing Pa went to Abrahams to bargain for wood Jimmie dug two loads of wood
- 11 Murdy went North. To stew 18 cts
- 12 Rain began 9.30. Prey cutting wood
- 20 I took to bed Wednesday, and was not up until today. I had a slight attack of bronchitis. Called Dr. Wood on Saturday he told me to remain in bed for some days, got 1 bottle medicine
- 21 Rain ugly weather
- 22. To stew 42 cts. Murdy got home but night 42
- The girls expected Hatty last night she did not come Mrs Gurn so very poorly. Birdie was there this afternoon
- 23 A very few in church. We got 100 off from Dunlop the beginning of last week 2.25
