 A very fine Day. Light Laughter  
 Buried to Day Leander working.  
 at the gun fired a shot out of it.  
 Randolph came this evening  
 took the Rime of the Wharf  
 a fortunate day. The last  
 day of fall. Leander and Randolph  
 went a fishing got 2 Dozen  
 went up to 2 Bouquets both  
 of them 21st first Day of Winter  
 and a very very fine Day  
 Working at a Pine stick 30 feet  
 Long Hewed a little of both sides  
 Stanley and I Raised it a little  
 in the Marsh. Unfortunate Day  
 22nd a Fortunate Day. Fine cool  
 Windy North Wind setting fires  
 turned the Boat 23rd Fine Gordon  
 came. Took the White Boat up from  
 Andrew Frasers 24th Fine Windy  
 at Stone wood Gordon and Stanley  
 went to fish last night got a Succour  
 turned windy 25th (Wednesday) Day  
 Leander and Randolph Fine Windy  
 came Jimmy Rose sick  
 Gordon here

James Cameron Island 26 Dec 1894  
 By Stephens Day Fine Gordon was  
 to Duncan G. Freezing and a Log at  
 the outside of the other Pine killed  
 4 Chickens High 2 Wind to night  
 drifted and snowed and Blowed  
 hard 27th St John the Evangelist Day  
 Free Masons a Big 2 Wind Storm  
 Blowing and Drifting hard Working  
 at Tobaccos 2 Sacks one with Loose  
 7 lbs 1 with Plugs 1 lb Ice Making  
 a little taken over to Frasers  
 28th Holy Innocents Day (C) Took  
 a great many air-holes and lots of  
 Big openings took home the sheep  
 one of them came freezing hard  
 to Day and to night something the  
 matter with the B Horse rats well  
 29th Our Anguis Butt Day  
 Leander crossed to Summerston  
 got the Parcel and a Letter  
 worth 10 in it Paid Haggarty  
 for paying for it got our 3 Week  
 mail 2 Coats 2 Pants 3 Vests  
 4 neckties a lot of collars 1 hat 1 cap  
 2 Bottles of shaving soap 1 Razor  
 3 Books a lot of Magazines
