Fri Jul 26<sup>th</sup> cloudy & thunder storm last night and fine rain that was much needed. not doing anything myself

Sat Jul 27<sup>th</sup> some thunder and clouds no rain work of Seaking of here was in the house most of the day Brother Bilton was here this after noon

Sun Jul 28<sup>th</sup> cloudy part of the day and hot

Mon Jul 29<sup>th</sup> cloudy and hot. a fine rain last night. not doing much myself Dick took a load of grain to Dresden for me

Tue Jul 30<sup>th</sup> clear most of the day high wind from the South west and hot not doing much to day

Wed Aug 31<sup>st</sup> light clouds and pleasant. I was down to the farm hoeing beans part of the fore noon not doing much the rest of the day.

Thu Aug 1<sup>st</sup> cloudy fore noon after noon clear and pleasant. a light shower last night. I split wood part of the day.

Fri Aug 2<sup>nd</sup> cloudy and cool. not doing anything

Sat Aug 3<sup>rd</sup> cloudy and cool. I was not doing much Brother Bilton was here visiting

Sun Aug 4<sup>th</sup> clear and cool. I went with Mr Newcomb to Florence to Quarterley Meeting

Mon Aug 5<sup>th</sup> clear and pleasant. I was down to the old place bagging corn in the fore noon. after Shelling corn for the chickens.

Tue Aug 6<sup>th</sup> clear and pleasant

Wed Aug 7<sup>th</sup> clear and hot. I was helping Dick get up some wood for thrashing and help load corn for Dresden Market

Thu Aug 8<sup>th</sup> clear and dry. I was helping Dick put up and get away a load of corn to Dresden

Fri Aug 9<sup>th</sup> cloudy and cool. was putting up a load of corn for Dresden.
