We finished potatoes today
 & I got the sugar beet lifter
 and lifted our beets all but
 1 drill. sent a pair of lockers
 to Fred W. Carty Boston and
 then ordered quilting frame
 ends. gave mother \$5²⁵ to
 buy quilting stuff. Had Prides
 in heat

Friday 23rd fair & cool

We finished with beet lifter
 & started to pull 9 top

Saturday 24th fair & cool

We topped most of the
 beets today

Sunday 25th fair

Father, Mother & I went to
 Church in morning and
 Children & I to S. D. 30-10-10-02

Monday 26th fair & cool

I took grit to mill in morning
 18 bgs. 90¢, Flour \$4⁰⁰, Oil cake
 \$12⁰⁰ Pd goldies bill \$12⁶⁵
 got quilting frames. 30⁰⁰
 rod fixed. 15⁰⁰

Tuesday 27th fair & cool

I shipped five lambs to Henry C
 Jewett. Telegram. 50⁰⁰ health papers
 \$1⁰⁰. Then we hauled five
 loads sugar beets to
 Hocking Valley Car. 2232. took
 1 load last night. got
 3 crates from Penfold's \$3⁰⁰

Wednesday 28th fine

We finished sugar beets
 this morning and hauled
 a load of manure home
 from W. Waddell's 50
 then I shipped the beets & got
 500⁰⁰ wire 98¢: then we
 topped turnips with hoes
 in afternoon,
