24 Fine day Jimmie & Murdy went to Alex Donalds to bid farewell to Lord Dunn Donald. He is to be at the Presbyterian Church, will lunch with J. Mc Donalds Greenfield

25 The boys put in four big loads of hay at home. They finished on the village farm. Pa had Currie shingling the R. of Kentail house. Got 1500 shingles from McArthur & son. 4.10 I made a pretty large washing list. The white clothes in water I washed 5 shirts of Murdy's, not starched,

26 Rain, did not put out washing Jimmie away all day

27 Fine day, 70 bread 20, Pa paid Currie 86.00 Sold 5 3/4 doz eggs (6-92, 70/10 B tea 40/1 Japan 25-

28 Rain drizzle

29 Mrs Archie McArthur Lancaster was buried here today. John Robertson N. B & Ferguson bore. took tea with us.

30 Fine day Jimmie fixed doors of barn & 2 loads  
70 3 lbs steak 30 charge

31 Rain not many in church, Mrs Rogers, (Maggie Falkner) sang a solo. "When I shall see him face to face" It was very fine.

August 1904

1 Fine day. Jimmie cut some hay on the loan

2 Jimmie put up about two loads of hay  
3 Kenneth from Dunvegan and Mary Mc Lennan from Scotland here all night - left today J. & P. & Co to Hamiltons Island. Only Murdy from here

4 Fine day. Jimmie has men working at hay. D. McRyman & team J. K. Mc H with one horse & young & aged W. Murray at Kate Dairywells. Mrs Gorn there. Margie Gorn has cramps and is afraid of appendicitis. I washed 3 sheets & 4 blankets

5 Fine day Jimmie is off to the hay Murdy is not back. did not turn up since the picnic Evening. Jimmie is through with the hay on back farm. Making, lost 7.81  
Put in 12 loads. Salway, made come on share our share 6 loads. Tom Hutton made some

7 Fine day looks like rain, fine large congregation

8 Dry day fixing my silk shirt

9 Sold 3 3/4 doz eggs 1 gall lard oil 20. 4 1/2 yds
