Frosty cloudy snowing and sunny thawing in the sun a little windy. Willie at Dix's thrashing to-day. I cut wood etc. Mother and Mary drove down in cutter (first time out) and Mary and Bella came up, post letter to 7. Dow 2 they brought Mrs Dunn. in for tea. Mrs Smith (lumber merchant) came in to see about getting load straw bought too bag mangols 25 cts

Frosty day sunny and cloudy calm fine. Willie at Fords thrashing to-day. Messrs Smith and Clark up in P.M. for me put on load straw which I took down to his place Recd \$3.00 for it then we brought over small bed hay from other barn.

Wednesday

Fine mild day not very frosty mostly cloudy. Willie at Shook's thrashing to-day. I took 900 lbs cow chop to Wilsons then hauled back load manure to No 6 in A.M. in P.M. we hauled back 3 loads manure then I went down for chop (49 cts) in sleigh. Mary down in P.M. got at Stubs spuds 14 cts she and Martha Bowley went collecting for B. Society with Lucy in cutter. Jane Cassidy killed by train to-day

Fine sunny day thawing thawing sleighing melted We hauled back 2 loads manure in sleigh in A.M. from box stall and in P.M. I took to Curbin 620 lbs pig chop took 2 chickens to our church for high tea 75 cts got ticket for loads at scales 16 cts
