5th I drove out to Sam Cochran

brothers Ins. to cut on Mon. at
10 cts a letter if marble & if Granite
15 cts. Each T & 1 for footstone
Thos. Hill worked some this
forenoon we both worked
this after-noon on shop
Adam Seal & wife were up
this eve was a nice day

6th Thos. Hill worked 9 hrs
to-day Ed Keating 8 hrs I
paid him 2.00 Les 7 hrs
he went home this eve
I gave Del. Smith \$1.00 for
1 bag of potatoes & hauling
I gave some lumber was
a nice day have left
to night \$11.75 afterwards
