Some Common Knee Affections—No. 2.

From an etiological standpoint this broad distinction may be made between the diseases of childhood and those of adult life. In the former as a rule the bacillus of tuberculosis is the all-important factor. In the latter trauma is the most important. Lest the statement may be regarded as too sweeping, let me add that trauma plays a very important role in the causation of *exacerbations* in the tuberculous diseases of bones in children, and that the object of treatment is to avoid and minimize the effects of traumata intrinsic, and extrinsic.—*Hunter; Mass.
