Sat July 29<sup>th</sup> thunder showers most of the day

Sun July 30<sup>th</sup> cloudy fore part of the day. I at the Sunday School but few there Victoria and her children was with me most of the day.

Mon July 31<sup>st</sup> clear part of the day and pleasant

Tue Aug 1<sup>st</sup> clear and cool. I was over to see John my Brother he don't appear to be much better

Wed Aug 2<sup>nd</sup> clear cool in morning warm the rest of the day
