 Sat 2 Milk 42, Corn flakes 25, bread 14 87
 Sun 3 Sent 25 to church. I went myself the 1st time since last summer. Began to take milk from Govies 25
 Mon 4 Ann 3/4 day 75^{cts} 2 loaves 12 87
 Agnes came by morning train, to begin taking the High School course. Paid 80^{cts} for 2 lbs of butter ^{Thursday} got on 80
 Tues 5 It was last night that Agnes came. This morning Katie Christie came with Josh to go to High School. Comfort soap 25, boiled oats 25 50
 Wed 6 Jimmie who left Sunday by his car for Cornwall to take train for Toronto. Came home by train left his car at Farguhers. The late rains made the roads very bad for motoring. 20 1 gall coal oil 18, Corn flakes 25- 25
 Thurs 7 Sent an account to W. G. for 15.⁰⁰ rent
 Fri 8 2 loaves 10 Agnes got, owe 2. 12
 Mrs Christie came for Johanna, Mrs Steward (who used to nurse Aunt Kate), called she looks well Jimmie and Mandy went to Cornwall
 Sat 9 Milk 42 bread 3 loaves 18, paid 2 we owed 62
 We are a week taking milk from Red Govies
 Sun 10 Very fine day Church 25 25
 Mon 11 Fine day Katie Christie and her Aunt Mrs Duncan Robertson of Montreal were here for dinner
 Tues 12 Jimmie took me to Lancaster to see Love the dress maker. I took dinner and tea Govies. I had two cavities filled and two roots extracted and an impression of the roof of my mouth taken
 Wed 13 Lovely day Boys went to Alexander to the Fair Gordon paid \$15⁰⁰

Wed 13 2 lbs butter 80 2 loaves 12 92
 Thurs 14 Very fine weather 2/3 coal oil 18 ginger 10 28
 bottle Spirits turpentine 15
 Fri 15 I was to go to Mrs Loves in Lancaster to get a dress fitted I gave my meas on Wednesday, a dress Jean gave me two years ago. Rained all day
 Sat 16 Milk 42, butter 80, 3 loaves, 21 1-43
 On the 15th I sent an order to Eatons for 1 yds of floor oil cloth 1⁰⁰ for yard for two yds wide 1 cushion slip 39^{cts} 1 black bead necklace 48^{cts} 87
 6 cards of black wool darning thread 14 14
 Sun 17 Sent 25 to church
 Mon 18 Mrs Ann 60^{cts} bread 12 Mrs Christie 72
 19 and Mrs Duncan Robertson and Katie came in time for tea Katie is to stay and help Jimmie for the Fair 2 loaves, Jimmie took a qt of milk extra from Govies, Ginger 10^{cts} 40
 Wed 20 Fine in morning 3 loaves 18^{cts} 4 lbs butter 80^{cts} 110
 1/4 Cream tartar 20 Borrowed \$2.00 from Jimmie
 The exhibit from some Guild in Montreal came last night Jimmie got it today all home made curtains, mats, lumbering robes, ends of home made flannel, Cousin Mary and Mrs McWhison called, Mary brought me a cake she called war cake It is good and plumbed them I gave her a pullet and 20^{cts}
 Thurs 21 First day of fair
 Fri 22 Rain last night Fine today Jean and Joe were shown. He came at 7 a M, She at 1.30 Returned at 4 30
