 Ritches with them 2 spools of Thread 10 pairs
 all this Breaking the Roads as they are
 all Blocked up Boiled 2 Gallons of Syrup
 10th Fine cutting Sumacks for sugar 13
 Wood on the P Port 11th one of the yearling
 Calves Dead got fast in the stall fine
 Dust good Boiling 40 pairs of safe 2 Wind
 Cutting Brush for the cows 12th Low Sunday
 in the Bush made Syrup 13th Boiling in the Bush
 made 40 lbs 13 made 30 lb seen 2 Indians
 Cropped from Christies Island over to the north
 shore 16th Randolph Dick Leander and Jim
 the Bush Boiling the Girls gathered safe
 17th Mr J Mc Dougall here and Alexander
 Lissy and Lissy Robe The Teacher he found
 the ice over 3rd foot thick in the channel
 he went back and sent the Team after
 the Girls as there was a good deal of water
 the ice got the globe of the 20th sent Mrs

 very slow Randolph shot a Hat the first
 ever he shot spreading manure a fine day
 a few hoams of snow this morning 26th Raining hard
 27th ice Jamming fine took away West Banking
 28th Frost last night taken away 2 Bankings but
 its 4 roze so hard we will leave it alone for
 while 4 roze hard last 2 Wind Snowing Day
 and fine shot a 1/2 lb ice Jamming before
 the Door 28th Grenada's first Snp to summer
 brew the saw logs to the Bank lots of snow and ice
 around the house 30th Randolph Cropped
 Bought of John Summers 1/2 50 Gallon Fry Lard
 Chamney 10 Laces 5 paid this) Bought of Mr Wood 5
 cents on Credit Leander H H and T to head of Island
 seen the fore the Grenada's first Snp Cornwall
 31st of May fine North east Wind high
 shot a yellow hammer from fences putting wood
 2nd of North Wind Randolph to 4 Livingston Boys
 of Mrs Cartney 2 Dollars of Calves Boots 1/2 5
 cents paid Bowls + Collar 1 Dollar paid Bought of Long
 Box of Matches 12 1/2 on Credit sold Rats 1/2 18
 stung out manure went to Sturgeon Island
 Leander and got a Duck
