

11 I & Henry finished <sup>Aug 1891</sup> ganging early started  
& borrowed some of the other boys began  
pulling Mummy Peas they are a little too  
green as they went & pulled them east  
of road at other place W. very very  
warm, being steady showers went  
over the lake this evening  
12 Boy drew in Peas west of road  
at other place A.M. I cut best of  
Oats west of stump fence at other  
place P.M. I B & A pulled Peas  
with rake in N.E. corner field  
P.M. H came & worked in my place  
before supper W. very fine & cool  
13 Boy finished pulling Peas at  
home & drew in east of road at  
other place & brought home a load  
of oats I went to Cedar Grove  
A.M. asked Red hands to thresh  
tomorrow & went to Cedar  
Grove P.M. W. very fine & clear  
14 W. Ressor threshed till early supper  
time all Fall Wheat & Barley very  
good yield Wheat about

Bunchly about 40 Bushels saw small  
load of Oats, 360 Sheaves 49 Bushels  
W. fine A.M. Cloudy a little drizzly  
P.M.  
15 Boy finished pulling Mummy  
Peas with day the W. pretty warm  
B moved Steamer to 3 Peas  
Sunday 16 I & A after supper  
& little ones went to Meeting at  
Whideman's remembers by B. C. P. & C.  
Whideman spoke on St. Mark & C.  
went to Memo Store to dinner & to  
Joseph Groves to supper W. fine  
17 Drew in Mummy Peas 7 loads then  
drew 5 loads out of N.E. corner  
field till evening I & H helped with  
team, W. fine warm  
18 Finished drawing Peas 10 loads till  
supper then I began cutting Oats  
west part of N.E. corner field W.  
very warm & clear I & Susanna went  
to Cedar Grove A.M. I went again  
P.M.  
19 I finished N.E. field & cut nearly all  
field back of orchard I went to Whideman  
A.M. W. Clear Sun very warm
