grated a little. Fannie came in & finished  
it I never saw anything so strong. Will  
tell his mother on fire Paul Bert old's Clara  
came home on Tuesday

Friday I wrote west wind. terrible frosts  
at night. froze the hens drink solid  
I tried to finish my wash had legs  
& sweep & dust. the school house it  
took me all the forenoon in rip. Ethel  
Montague dress frocks & Marjorie faced  
it & sewed the frocks on & she got it at  
night. Fannie Spencer came & stayed all  
night - got by supper  
Sat. 8 terrible cold north west wind  
she went in Hills after dinner came  
back & went in Martin Wells. I made  
two pies & cleaned the floor. Paul  
rode in Chippawa with Maggie & only  
for eggs 15 or dox had 2 doz. got a box  
of herring. Fannie went in Bertie road  
asoon in Chippawa with Ed & Pet  
Sun 9 beautiful day a little warmer we  
got a dozen eggs a day now. Annie  
Marshall in dinner over to the other  
house. Hannie & Arthur Don Well on  
the evening. church Sunday  
Mon 10. we got no sleep last night  
on account of the horse pounding  
so much. drizzling rain most of the  
day. but did not amount to much  
Arthur working up at the head of the lot  
Paul caught 9 fish we had them for
